A Technical Analyst for Messerschmidt Safety Consultants (MSC) providing accident investigation and reconstruction services throughout Alabama, Tennessee, Georgia, Mississippi, and around the nation, Jeffrey Standridge first began his professional career in safety as an Alabama State Trooper Cadet in 1980. Jeff Standridge retired from the Alabama State Troopers in 2004 at the rank of Captain, overseeing all Highway Patrol Operations in the northern half of Alabama.

During Jeff Standridge's first post as an AL State Trooper, he became a Traffic Homicide Investigator, and in 1985 Standridge earned his first certification as a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) Inspector. In 1989, Jeff Standridge joined the State Trooper's elite Major Accident Investigation Team (MAIT); he served as the Supervisor and Accident Reconstructionist for the MAIT team for 10 years.

During his career as an Alabama State Trooper, Jeffrey Standridge investigated / reconstructed thousands of traffic crashes. As a supervisor and accident reconstructionist, Jeff was also responsible for overseeing and checking the work of other State Troopers in the Highway Patrol Division. He has completed over 750 classroom hours of training in accident investigation, accident reconstruction, and commercial vehicle safety.

Currently Jeff Standridge serves as an Adjunct Instructor at the Alabama State Trooper Academy in Selma, Alabama, and also for the Northeast Alabama Police Academy, in Jacksonville, Alabama. At the police academies he teaches topics including traffic accident investigation, accident reconstruction, traffic homicide investigation, supervision, and a leadership course for all Department of Public Safety (DPS) supervisors, which he developed and has taught since 2008.
